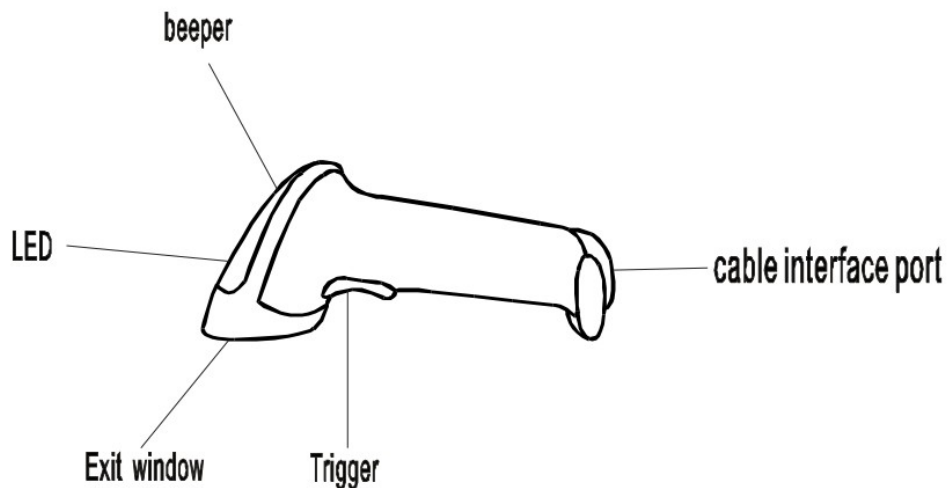

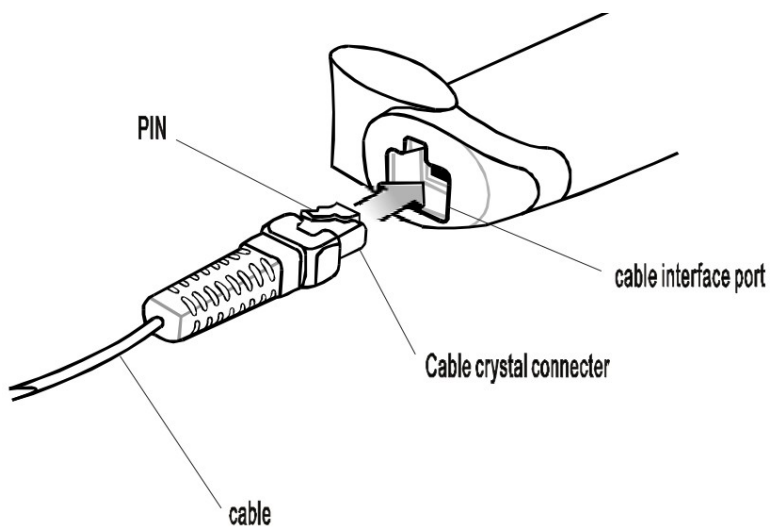

Installing the interface cable

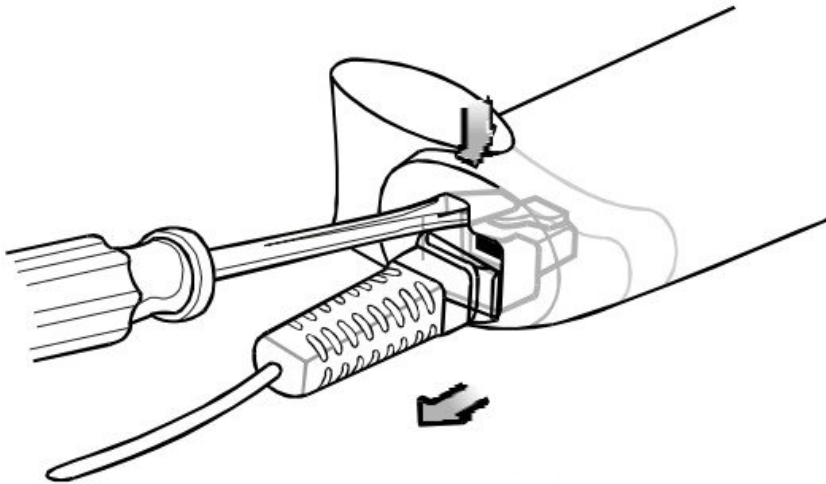
- 1.Plug the interface cable modular connector into the cable interface port on the bottom of the scanner handle(see figure2)
- 2.Gently tug the cable to ensure the connector is property secured
- 3.Connect the other end of the interface cable to the host

Removing the interface cable

1. Unplug the installed cable's modular connector by depressing the connector clip with the tip of a screwdriver
2. Carefully slide out the cable
3. Follow the steps for the interface cable on page to connect a new cable

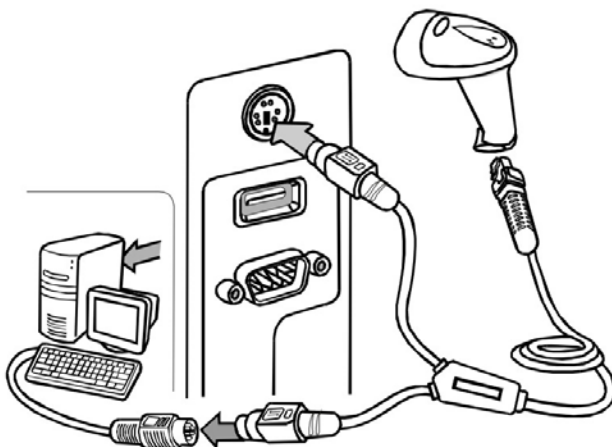

KBW Connection with Y-cable

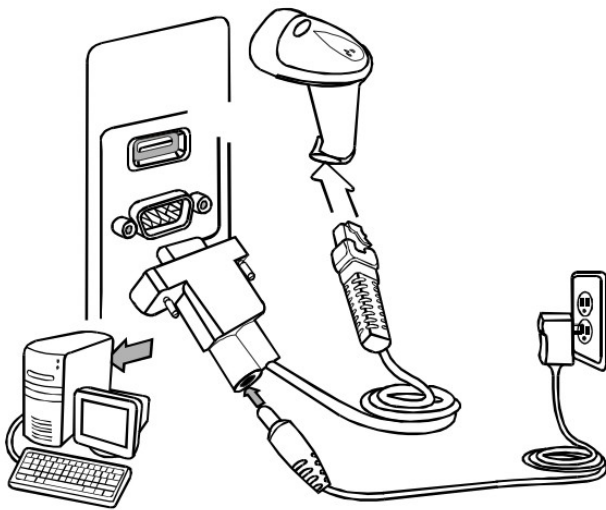
1. Switch off the host and unplug the keyboard connector

RS-232 Direct Connection

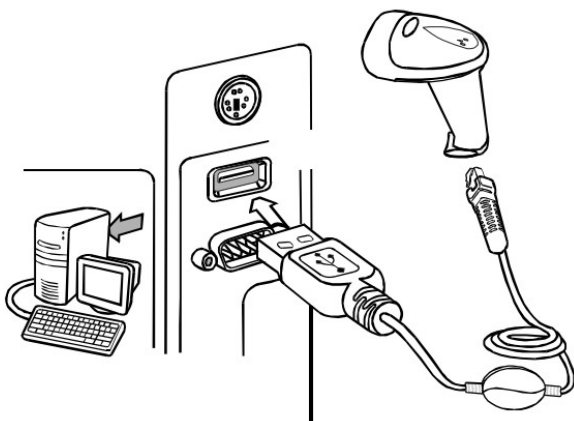
1. Switch off the host

Using The Advanced Setting Mode To Configure The Bar code

Scanner

The scanner can be configured by using the computer keyboard . The scanner must be installed and powered to enter the setting mode. Once the scanner is powered up ,please press and hold the following keys to finish setting

Left-Control ,Caps Lock, Right-Shift ,and Backspace¹

-or-

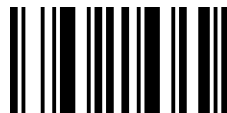
Left-Control,F2,Right-Shift,and Backspace²

Once you release the keys , the decoder will produce a series of beeps , change the LED to orange and display a message similar to the following on your display:

F1-F10=Options, Use ARROW KEYS to Toggle/Move ,ESC=Exit

To ensure that you have enough space on your command line for the scanner options to be displayed ,we recommend that you either have your command prompt located at the root directory or you load an editor with a new file. This will allow the scanner to use most of the characters on your computer display , for example,in Windows load ,Windows Write and in OS/2 load the Notepad program
